4. How these tests were run

Each scan loads the site in a desktop Chromium browser and runs axe-core stub-test with the WCAG 2.0, 2.1 and 2.2 Level A and AA rule sets. It tests the pages customers use to buy or book (home, a product, the cart and the first checkout screen for stores; menu, ordering and reservations for restaurants) plus any pages a letter cites.

Pages tested in the latest scan: Home (<http://127.0.0.1:37321/>); Product: Canvas tote (<http://127.0.0.1:37321/products/canvas-tote>); Cart (<http://127.0.0.1:37321/cart>); Checkout start (<http://127.0.0.1:37321/checkout>); Cited: /pages/contact (<http://127.0.0.1:37321/pages/contact>).

Limits: automated tests find only part of WCAG failures. Keyboard use, focus order, captions, meaningful alt text and screen reader flow need a person to check. A clean automated result is not proof that a site conforms to WCAG or complies with the ADA.
